

Courses:

General English 9am – 3pm

This course is available at levels from Beginner to Advanced. It is designed to improve every aspect of English to make communication more clear and fluent.

We focus on speaking, listening, reading, writing and grammar. At the end of the course you will receive a New Horizon Certificate to confirm successful completion.

General English 9am-12noon

This is designed for visitors who just want to brush up their English while on holiday in New Zealand. Not recommended for the more serious student.

IELTS Preparation *Intermediate level and above*

Students planning to go to University or further academic study can attend the IELTS Preparation course. This includes practice tests and study skills. IELTS is required for entry into University or Polytechnic.

Cambridge Examination Preparation

For students planning to take FCE or CAE, courses are available 3 times a year.

TOEIC Preparation Option 1-3pm

Intermediate level and above

We offer TOEIC Preparation courses as an afternoon option for General English students interested in International business. The TOEIC examination is held for our students only, every 2 months.

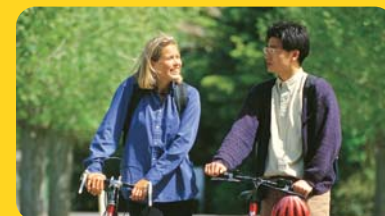

Napier

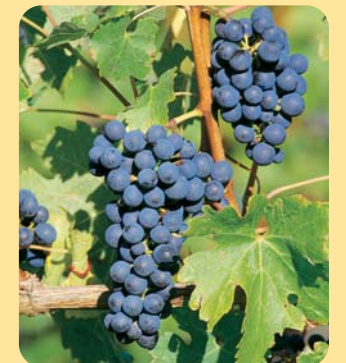
Napier is a beautiful seaside city with a warm Mediterranean climate. Napier was built in Art Deco style and is known as the Art Deco city.
