The School

COLC is located in a renovated old Kauri villa beside the Whitianga harbour and only a few minutes walk from the centre of town. The original part of the building is one of the oldest houses in town and is surrounded by beautiful grounds that are available for games and students' recreation. English language teaching is our main focus. Our highly qualified and experienced teachers and selection of courses will provide excellent learning opportunities. Small classes mean more teacher time and better progress. Morning lessons form the basis of all our courses with various options available in the afternoons.

General Course

This is our standard, and most popular course. 21 hours a week of skills based, and conversation classes, combined with the opportunity to go out into the community and practice the language you are learning in real life situations.

Examination Preparation Course

COLC specialises in FCE. While many schools are moving toward CAE we will continue to offer FCE preparation courses, for which have always had excellent results. If you are serious about success in your FCE, we can provide the learning environment you need.

Morning lessons will be followed by 2 hours of intensive exam preparation Monday to Thursday.

Morning Lessons with Activities

Available from October to April, this unique and popular course combines morning lessons with outdoor activities in the afternoons. "Learning by Doing" is English learning in action!

English Plus 3

This course is available all year round and combines morning lessons with 3 afternoon activities (Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday). On the other days students can enjoy free afternoons or have one-to-one lessons.

Nearly all of our students try activities for a least a short time, and the majority wish they had started sooner. This is a wonderful way to see what the Coromandel Peninsula has to offer and to enjoy 'learning by doing' while interacting with teachers, local artists and personalities.









Homestay

We regard homestay as a very important part of our programme. Our host families feel that they are part of the school, and enjoy the privilege of having students from other cultures to stay with them. The school ensures that the homes are of a high standard, and that families are made aware of the challenges which foreign students face in adapting to New Zealand life. Unless specially requested, we do not place two students of the same nationality with the same host family.

Universal Lodge
