### Textbooks

Students pay on arrival at the school. Students must buy textbooks (\$60-\$110). If they keep the books for less than two weeks and return them in excellent condition, all money is refunded. If they have the books for more than two weeks and return them in excellent condition, some money is refunded.

### Friday afternoons

On Friday afternoons, full-time students have the choice of:

- joining the Friday afternoon activity with a RELA tutor, or
- self-study using RELA facilities and materials, or
- free time

If a part-time morning student wants to join an afternoon activity, the cost is \$54 per day

If a full-time student wants to upgrade to activities, the cost is \$40 per day.

If a part-time morning student wants to upgrade to full-time, the cost is \$115 per week.

## Fees Protection Policy

Rotorua English Language Academy provides its students with protection against the loss of their fees in the event of insolvency, closure, voluntary withdrawal of a course by RELA or withdrawal of school accreditation.

The Academy protects student fees by depositing them in the Trust Account managed by the Public Trust. This is a New Zealand Government guaranteed Student Fee Trust Account, with progressive withdrawal of fees by the school during the student's course. On arrival in New Zealand, the student is asked to sign an application for the operation of his or her Student Fee Trust Account.
